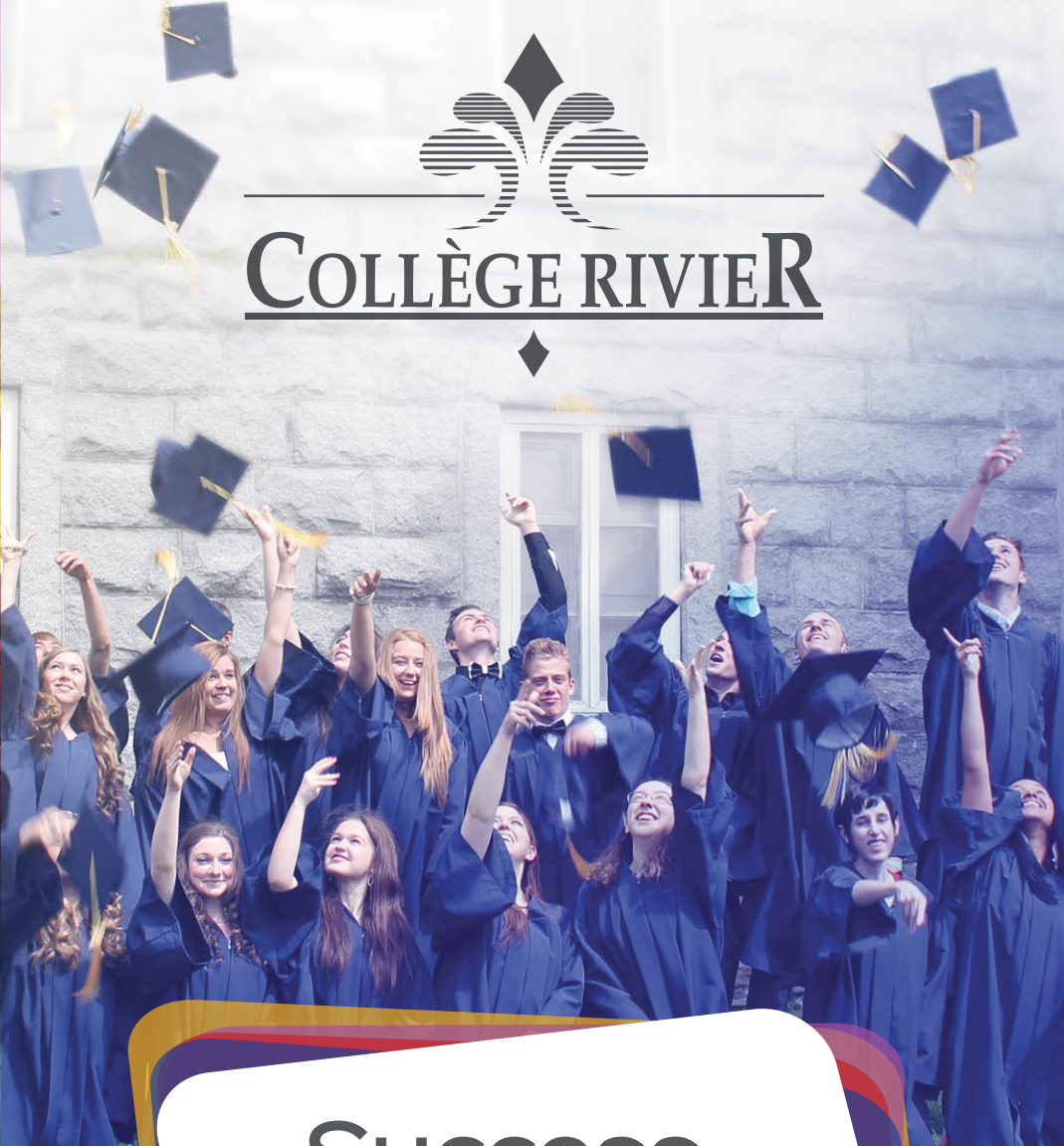

## HOCKEY

**HOCKEY-STUDY PROGRAM**

This profile is offered to students who enjoy hockey and wish to develop their abilities and their knowledge. Since, at the College the approach used is one based on a personalized education, the program is inclusive. Students from all levels (C to AA) are accepted and accompanied through their growth and progression. The students will participate at a school organized hockey league and stay within their minor hockey leagues if applicable. This profile allows the student to play 6 periods of hockey within a 10 day cycle, as well as in the games and physical education periods. The program runs throughout the year from September until June and is offered to both boys and girls.



## LANGUAGES

The College permits capable students to finish their high school leaving with French and English mother tongue, otherwise known as English Language Arts. The students within the intensive program progress at an accelerated pace and finish their level 5 English as a second language in level 3 and continue with the ELA program in level 4 & 5. We also offer a francisation program for Allophone or Anglophone students who wish to learn French. Once again, the program is personalised and is based on individual needs. Spanish courses are also offered.
